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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this compilation is to mainly provide a research tool for those local descendants interested in their family histories. It also provides the researcher with a reference tool for local and state history. The brief descriptions provide a subject entry even though they are not listed alphabetically.

On Saturday morning, June 6, 1857, Preston B. Plumb published the first issue of the "Kanzas News." Eighteen year old Plumb was the editor and proprietor of the first newspaper in the southeastern portion of Kansas Territory.

Plumb continued to publish the "Kanzas News" until January 22, 1859, when Jacob Stotler became proprietor and editor. On August 15, 1859, Stotler changed the name of the paper to the "Emporia News."

This index covers the life of the "Kanzas News." It was during this time that Emporia began developing into the thriving city it is today. The newspaper covered a wide range of news for the early settlers. National, state, and local news was published. Emporia was settled during the period of time that Kansas was known as "Bleeding Kansas." The territory was torn between the free state and slave state issue. Each newspaper published took the free or slave state stand. The "Kanzas News" was strongly free state and later supported the Republican Party. The support for the free states was voiced strongly at the local level by the first settlers of Emporia.

It is the local people that the indexer has compiled. This includes settlers of Emporia and the surrounding communities who were affiliated with Emporia and Breckinridge County (now Lyon County). The names were selected when Emporia or the surrounding communities were mentioned or implied with

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the name. Most of the names were associated with political affairs and the names were often mentioned on page three, column one, which represents the local news. Every time the name was mentioned it was recorded even though it may have reappeared in several issues with the same article. This may seem repetitious, but the index was compiled to be all comprehensive. It should be noted, however, that names were not recorded from classified ads as this would have been repetitious and time consuming. Names were, therefore, only taken from articles, general notices and administration notices and sales..

The format of the index is as follows: name, issue date, page and column and brief description; for example, Plumb, Preston B., (ed.), 6-6-57, 2:1, Salutatory for paper. The names are in alphabetical order. Some names may have letters in parenthesis. This indicates different spellings of the name found in the newspaper.

The appendix is a list of letters found in several issues. It was felt this list was not necessary to be indexed, but could be used just as simply as it is as all the names are in alphabetical order. All known issues of the "Kanzas News" were indexed.

Introduction

The Emporia Public Library and the William Allen White Library of Emporia State University each possess one reel of microfilmed newspapers dating 6 Jun 1857--12 May 1860.

Volume 1 was named THE KANZAS NEWS and is dated 6 Jun 1857 - 24 Jul 1858; Volume 2 was named THE KANSAS NEWS and is dated 31 Jul 1858 - 6 Aug 1859; and Volume 3, named THE EMPORIA NEWS is represented by issues 1 - 40, dated 13 Aug 1859 - 12 May 1860.

THE KANZAS NEWS INDEX, 1857-1859, covering Volumes 1 and 2, was prepared and copyrighted by Steven F. Hanschu in 1975. Copies of his index are available for use at both of the above named libraries.

This index for the Volume 3 issues on the microfilm reel was prepared by this compiler, a newcomer to the area, as he scanned the reel contents to become acquainted with the area and time. The entries consist essentially of four parts -- a name, a reason for being, the page/column numbers and the issue date of the newspaper. Following Mr. Hanschu's example, only names and events appearing to be 'local' were indexed except for the 7 Jan 1860 issue. That issue was indexed completely for the advertisements, most of which appear in every preceding and following issues.
